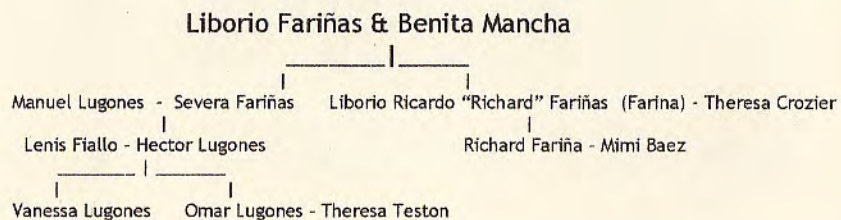


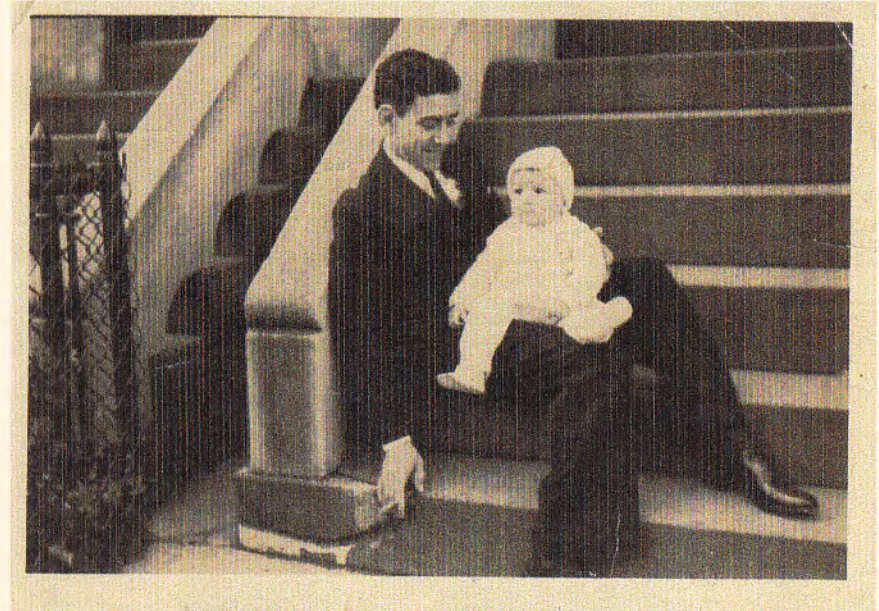

Fariñas Family Tree (partial)

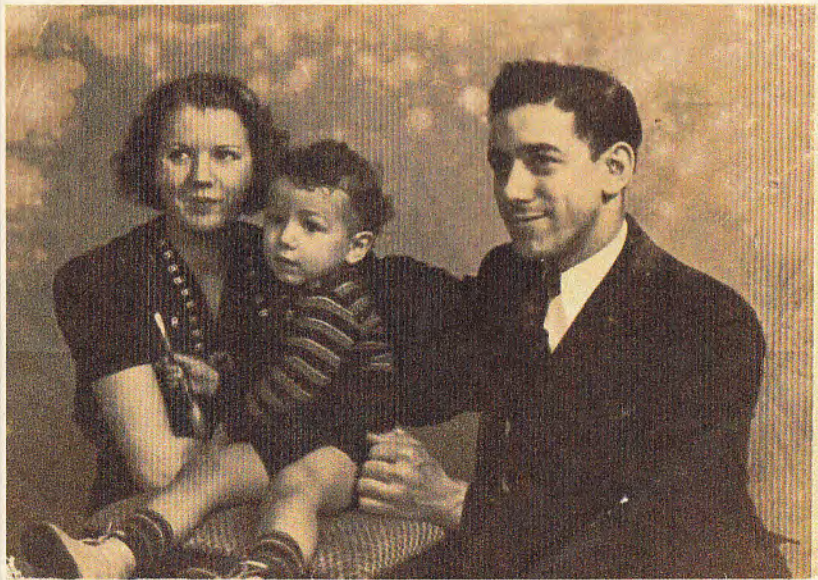

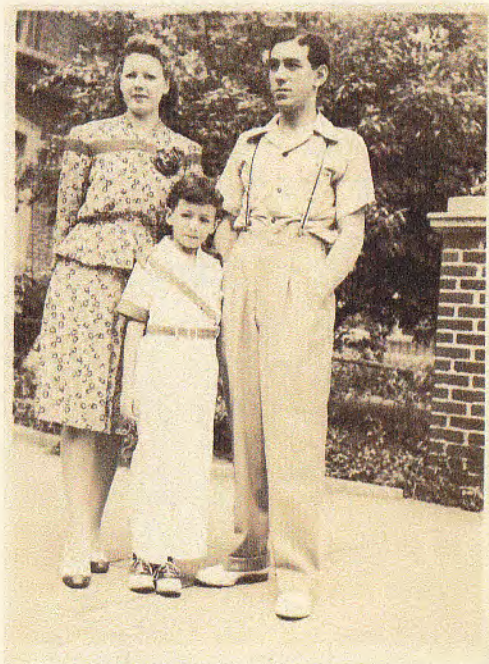

Richard and his parents, circa 1938



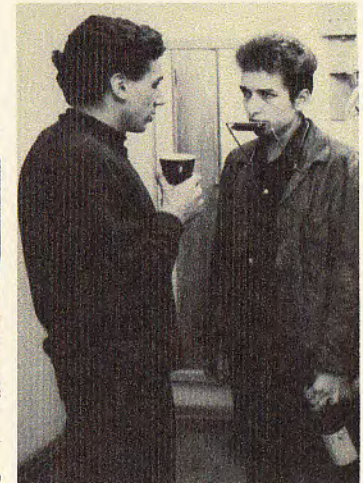
Richard and his parents, 1944
